

**RESOLUTION R-08-125**

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HARRISON REQUESTING THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS TO CONDUCT AN ADMINISTRATIVE INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE IF DEPUTY MAYOR ROBERT S. CAMPBELL VIOLATED ANY ETHICS LAWS AND THE PUBLIC TRUST**

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee of South Harrison Township appointed a special investigatory sub-committee for the purpose of investigating all municipal officers, employees and appointed officials in relationship to an alleged breach of the Township's computer system on or about April 16, 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, Committeemen Spinner and McCall were appointed to serve on the special investigatory sub-committee; and

**WHEREAS**, the special investigatory sub-committee has conducted and concluded their investigation into the alleged breach of the Township's computer system; and

**WHEREAS**, the special investigatory sub-committee recommended the forwarding of their report to the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison that the Report and Findings Surrounding the Alleged Computer Breach of the South Harrison Township Computer System dated December 29, 2008 be forwarded to the Department of Community Affairs and requesting the Department of Community Affairs to conduct an administrative investigation to determine if Deputy Mayor Robert S. Campbell violated any ethics laws and the public trust.
