**RESOLUTION REVOKING THE DESIGNATION OF UNITY SERVICE AMBULANCE
AS THE DESIGNATED QUALIFIED FIRST AID, RESCUE AND AMBULANCE
SQUAD FOR SOUTH HARRISON TOWNSHIP
AND DESIGNATING GLOUCESTER COUNTY EMS AS THE EMS PROVIDER FOR
SOUTH HARRISON**

WHEREAS, the current provider of Emergency Medical Service for South Harrison Township is Unity Service Ambulance; and

WHEREAS, the Committee of the Township of South Harrison desires to facilitate better Emergency Medical Service to the citizens of South Harrison Township through participation in the Gloucester County Emergency Medical Service and therefore the certification of Unity Service Ambulance as the designated qualified first aid, rescue and ambulance squad for South Harrison Township is hereby revoked; and

WHEREAS, a written agreement has been provided by the County of Gloucester to be executed by the Mayor of the Township of South Harrison so as to utilize the services of the Gloucester County Emergency Medical Service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey that the certification of Unity Service Ambulance as the designated qualified first aid, rescue and ambulance squad for South Harrison Township is hereby revoked and that the Committee hereby designates Gloucester County Emergency Medical Services as the Township's EMS provider and authorizes Mayor Robert S. Campbell to enter into a Shared Services Agreement (attached

hereto) with the County of Gloucester in order to utilize the Gloucester County Emergency Medical Service.

This resolution was adopted at a regular meeting of the Township Committee on March 11, 2009 and shall take effect April 5, 2009.
