

**SOUTH HARRISON TOWNSHIP
GLOUCESTER COUNTY**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HARRISON
COMMITTEE TO TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40:5-2**

WHEREAS, the Committee of the Township of South Harrison has by way of resolution revoked the certification of Unity Service Ambulance as the designated first aid, rescue and ambulance squad for South Harrison Township; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:5-2 allows the Township of South Harrison to appropriate sums as it may deem necessary for the purchase of first aid, ambulance, rescue or other emergency vehicles, equipment, supplies and materials to the Township's designated first aid, rescue and ambulance squad; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:5-2 states the title to said equipment, purchased with monies provided by the municipality, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:5-2, remains with the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Township of South Harrison has appropriated various monies to Unity Service Ambulance, during the time in which Unity Service Ambulance was the designated first aid, rescue and ambulance squad for South Harrison Township, to purchase first aid, ambulance, rescue or other emergency vehicles, equipment, supplies and materials.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey that the Township Committee is authorized to take the appropriate action, including litigation, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:5-2, to procure any first aid, ambulance, rescue or other emergency vehicles, equipment, supplies and materials purchased by Unity Service Ambulance through monies appropriated by the Township of South Harrison.

This resolution was adopted at a regular meeting of the Township Committee on March 11, 2009 and shall take effect immediately.
