**RESOLUTION REDUCING CERTAIN WORK HOURS AND COMPENSATION
OF CERTAIN TOWNSHIP EMPLOYEES BASED UPON BUDGETARY AND
ECONOMIC NEEDS**

WHEREAS, the Township of South Harrison is in the process of preparing its budget for the year 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Township has made an effort to engage in various cost saving measures, including but not limited to, reductions in its work force and staffing, and hours of that work force and staffing; and

WHEREAS, given the realities of the current economic situation in the nation, and particularly in the State of New Jersey, with declining tax revenues, and decreasing municipal aid, as well as in consideration of an encouragement from State and County government to engage in certain shared services with neighboring municipalities, the Township of South Harrison Committee has been required to make certain tough decisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey that the following reductions in employee work hours in the Clerk's Office of Township of South Harrison hereby impose effective May 18, 2009 for the following employees:

Nancy Kearns, Municipal Clerk – A reduction from 37.5 hours per week to 24 hours per week

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey that a corresponding reduction in

compensation from the Township to the above set forth employees shall be calculated, effective from the date of May 14, 2009, for the balance of the calendar year ending December 31, 2009.

This resolution was adopted at a regular meeting of the Township Committee on May 13, 2009 and shall take effect immediately.
