

**RESOLUTION - R-09-108**

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HARRISON AUTHORIZING CERTAIN REDUCTIONS IN STAFF FOR BUDGETARY REASONS**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of South Harrison is faced with certain budgetary constraints and short falls in the foreseeable future; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee is required to make fiscally responsible budgetary decisions in order to ensure the long-term financial stability of the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, certain Township Departments were requested to make reductions in costs, salaries and other expenses in order to address the concerns of the Township Committee concerning finances, including the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, certain reductions are necessary in said Department in order to maintain the long-term fiscal stability of the Township.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison, County of Gloucester, and State of New Jersey, hereby requires the immediate reduction in force in the Police Department, eliminating two (2) positions effective September 18, 2009:

- (1) Elimination of the one (1) Special Law Enforcement Officer (SLEO) Position with the Township of South Harrison Police Department;
- (2) Reduction in force of one (1) Police Officer Position by way of lay off of the Police Officer with the least seniority.

This resolution was adopted at a regular meeting of the Township Committee on September 9, 2009 and shall take effect immediately.
