

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HARRISON CERTIFYING THE TAX LEVY ASSOCIATED WITH THE KINGSWAY REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET

WHEREAS, at the annual school election held on April 20, 2010, the voters of the Kingsway Regional High School District, comprised of East Greenwich Township, South Harrison Township, Borough of Swedesboro and the Township of Woolwich rejected the proposed tax levy submitted by the Kingsway Regional Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 18A:22-37 mandates certain procedures to be followed by the Township Governing Body and the Board of Education upon such rejection; and

WHEREAS, the Township Governing Body Sub-Committee consulted with the Board of Education for purposes of arriving at a tax levy sufficient to assure the provision of a thorough and efficient education; and

WHEREAS, the Township Governing Body has identified certain line item reductions in the proposed school board budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township of South Harrison in the County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey hereby certifies to the Gloucester County Board of Taxation that the total of the amounts so determined to be necessary to be raised by taxation for the 2010/2011 school year for the Kingsway Regional Board of Education are as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township Committee hereby certifies that it has reviewed the revised budget and determined that it is sufficient to assure the provision of a thorough and efficient system of education.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to provide certified copies of this resolution to the Gloucester County Board of Taxation; the Gloucester County Superintendent of Schools; and the Kingsway Regional Board of Education.
