

RESOLUTION R-11-75

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY REPAIR CONTRACT FOR LINCOLN MILL ROAD PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A.40A:11-6

WHEREAS, Hurricane Irene caused the destruction of a portion of Lincoln Mill Road within the Township of South Harrison; and

WHEREAS, the destruction to the aforementioned roadway within the Township constitutes an emergency affecting the public health, safety and welfare of the Township's residents; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has solicited quotes to perform the emergency repairs required on Lincoln Mill Road and has otherwise certified the emergency pursuant to N.J.S.A.40A:11-6; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer has reviewed all quotes received by the Township and has otherwise recommended the award of the Lincoln Mill Road Emergency Repair Project to South State, Inc., for a base bid sum of Thirty Five Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Seven Dollars and Fifteen Cents (\$35,287.15); and

WHEREAS, the Engineer has also determined that the quote received by South State, Inc., was the lowest responsible quote and that the Contractor is qualified to perform the work specified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison, that the Township finds and determines that the quote submitted by South State, Inc., is the lowest responsible quote received for the Lincoln Mill Road – Emergency Road Repair Project, and the said South State, Inc., is hereby awarded a Contract in the amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Seven Dollars and Fifteen Cents (\$35,287.15); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this award of Contract is an emergency Contract under N.J.S.A.40A:11-6 and is subject to further compliance of the successful Contractor with all others terms and conditions established by the Township Engineer and Township Solicitor.
