CONTRACT FOR DOG CENSUS

THIS CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 11th day of January 2012 by and between the TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HARRISON and the SOCIETY TO PROTECT ANIMALS, an incorporated non-profit organization.

1. The Society will canvass the residents on a door-to-door basis, to determine the dog population for that municipality. A flyer will be left at each home stating that a current license must be purchased for each dog in the municipality over the age of seven months.
2. The Society will compare results of the census with the currently issued licenses. The Society will mail warnings to those found in violation, giving them additional time to purchase a license.
3. The Society will issue summons to all dog owners who fail to license dogs on their premises.
4. The Society will appear at Court, if necessary, to present evidence on behalf of the Municipality concerning the alleged violation.
5. The census will commence after February 1 and will be complete on or before September 1, 2012. A copy of the completed census will be sent to the New Jersey Department of Health for their records.
6. The Society will be paid the sum of \$3,500.00 for these services, half of which will be paid on May 1, 2012 and the balance to be paid upon completion.
