

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HARRISON
TO AUTHORIZE AUTOMATIC LICENSE PLATE READERS
IN ACCORDANCE WITH NEW JERSEY ATTORNEY GENERAL
DIRECTIVE 2010-5**

WHEREAS, The Officer in Charge, Nicholas Priore, has proposed a Uniform Policy and Procedure for the use of Automatic License Plate Readers (ALPRs) by the South Harrison Township Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Automatic License Plate Reader system will provide law enforcement personnel with the capability to read license plates and check those license plates against numerous data bases to identify individuals who may be wanted by other law enforcement agencies and vehicles which may have been used in criminal activities; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Uniform Policy and Procedure Order is to permit and authorize the Township of South Harrison Police Department to utilize ALPR technology to the extent possible in accordance with New Jersey Attorney General Directive 2010-5; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Policy and Procedure has been reviewed by all interested parties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison, that the Uniform Policy and Procedure Order annexed hereto is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Uniform Policy and Procedure Order, as attached hereto and made a part hereof, be added to the Policy Manual of the South Harrison Township Police Department forthwith after the adoption;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution, as well as the Uniform Policy, be forwarded to the Gloucester County Prosecutor's Office forthwith after the adoption hereof.
