RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY APPROVING CALENDAR YEAR 2011 PARTICIPATION WITH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY IN A SAFE AND SECURE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE, DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY

WHEREAS, the Township of South Harrison wishes to apply for a project under the Safe and Secure Communities Program; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee have reviewed the application and have approved said request; and

WHEREAS, the project is a joint effort between the Department of Law and Public Safety and the Applicant Local Unit of Government, for the purpose described in the application;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison that as a matter of public policy South Harrison Township wishes to retroactively participate to the fullest extent possible with the Department of Law and Public Safety for Calendar Year 2011 funding. The Attorney General of New Jersey will receive funds on behalf of the Applicant. The Division of Criminal Justice shall be responsible for the receipt and review of the applications for said funds. The Division of Criminal Justice shall initiate allocations to the applicant as authorized by law.
