

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING MUNICIPAL PROSECUTOR
AND ALTERNATE MUNICIPAL PROSECUTOR FOR THE
TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HARRISON**

WHEREAS, the services of a Municipal Prosecutor and Alternate Municipal Prosecutor are required for the calendar year 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A.40A:11-1, et seq.) requires that the Resolution authorizing the award of contracts for "Professional Services" without competitive bids must be publicly advertised; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A.2B:25-4(a) further permits appointments of Municipal Prosecutors and Alternate Municipal Prosecutors; and

WHEREAS, the below Appointees are qualified under the Statute to serve in their respective positions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison as follows:

1. That **AUGUSTA PISTILLI, ESQ.**, be and is hereby appointed Municipal Prosecutor for the term commencing January 1, 2013, and ending December 31, 2013; and
2. That **KELLY CONROY, ESQ.**, be and is hereby appointed Alternate Municipal Prosecutor to serve in the absence or conflict of the Municipal Prosecutor of the Township of South Harrison for the term commencing January 1, 2013, and ending December 31, 2013;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that these appointments are awarded as "Professional Services" under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law because said appointments encompass professional services recognized, licensed and regulated by law;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution shall be published in the South Jersey Times within ten (10) days of its adoption.
