

**RESOLUTION R-13-54**

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HARRISON  
AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A SHARED SERVICES  
AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER FOR USE  
OF THE COUNTY'S PUBLIC WORKS VEHICLE WASH FACILITY**

**WHEREAS**, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A.40A:65-1, et seq., authorizes local units, including counties and municipalities, to enter into agreements for the provision of Shared Services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of South Harrison desires to enter into a Shared Services Agreement with the COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER in order to utilize the County's Public Works Vehicle Wash Facility at the Department of Public Works Clayton Yard; and

**WHEREAS**, the County, through its Department of Public Works, has the capacity to provide such service and facilities to the Township.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison, County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Township Clerk of the Township of South Harrison are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute a Shared Services Agreement with the COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER for the use of the County's Public Works Vehicle Wash Facility at the Department of Public Works Clayton Yard.
2. A copy of the Shared Services Agreement is on file and available for public inspection at the Township Clerk's Office.
3. An original executed Shared Services Agreement signed by the Mayor and Township Clerk shall be forwarded directly to the COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER forthwith after the adoption hereof.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and adoption hereof.
