

RESOLUTION R-14-26

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR TRANSFERS OF 2013 APPROPRIATION RESERVES

WHEREAS, there are certain 2013 Reserve Budget Appropriations of the Township of South Harrison with balances insufficient to meet the anticipated expenditures; and

WHEREAS, there is an excess in one or more of the 2013 Reserve Budget Appropriations, over and above the amount deemed necessary to fulfill the purpose of such appropriations; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-59 provides for transfers from appropriation reserves with an excess over and above the amount deemed to be necessary to fulfill such purpose, to any appropriation reserve for the immediately preceding fiscal year deemed to be insufficient.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of the full membership thereof affirmatively concurring) that the following transfers are hereby authorized to be made by and between the 2013 Reserve Budget Appropriations:
