

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HARRISON AMENDING
THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HARRISON TO ADD
CHAPTER 113 ENTITLED "REGULATION OF ACTIVITY AT STEWART PARK"**

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison has determined that certain activities at Stewart Park can jeopardize the health and welfare of the citizens of South Harrison Township and the general public who utilize Stewart Park; and

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Township Committee that the striking or driving of golf balls at Stewart Park places the patrons of the park in jeopardy for injury either by being struck by a golf ball or by falling or tripping over golf balls left in the park; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined that there is a need to regulate such activity at Stewart Park;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of South Harrison, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey that the Township Code shall hereby be amended to add Chapter 113 entitled "Regulation of Activity at Stewart Park", which shall read as follows:

Chapter 113. Regulation of Activity at Stewart Park.

§113-1. Purpose.

The purpose of this Chapter is to regulate activity at Stewart Park for the safety of the patrons of the Park.

§113-2. Prohibition of Golf.

The driving, striking or otherwise hitting of golf balls at Stewart Park is prohibited by the Township of South Harrison.

The following acts are hereby declared to be examples in violation of this section:

- a. The driving, striking or otherwise hitting in any way of golf balls within the confines of Stewart Park.

The above enumeration is intended to give typical illustrations of prohibited acts and shall not be construed as exclusive.

§113.3 Violations.

Any person or persons who shall be in violation of this Chapter of the Code of the Township of South Harrison shall be punished as provided in §1-14 of this Code. Each violation of any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed and taken to be a separate and distinct offense.

§113.4

All ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

§113.5

If any word, phrase, clause, section or provision of this ordinance shall be found by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, illegal or unconstitutional, such word, phrase, clause, section or provision shall be severable from the balance of the Ordinance and the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage, adoption and publication as provided by law.
