South Harrison Township Residents,

On Monday, May 31st, 2021 (Memorial Day) at 2122 hours, multiple residents along US Route 45, in the area of Ashford Court, reported what they believed to be gunshots, coming from an unknown moving vehicle.

Two of the reporting residents supplied exterior home surveillance, which captured three loud bangs, alleged to be gunshots. Also captured at the time of the incident was an unknown dark colored pickup truck traveling along US Route 45.

Officers immediately responded to the area and began conducting an investigation. No physical evidence of gunfire was located at the scene. The driver of the truck, and a passenger, were later identified and interviewed. Both fully cooperated with our investigation and neither are suspects at this time.

Our Detective Division conducted a thorough follow-up investigation into the incident. At this time, there is no evidence to confirm that the "bangs" are in fact gunshots. In addition, there is no evidence to affirm that the "bangs" originated from the truck or its occupants.
