Latest update on tornado support and clean-up efforts.

Thank you to all who have donated time and resources to help with clean up efforts. Some of our neighboring communities have a long way to go and the support from Federal, State, Counties and Municipalities will continue until it's complete. I know parts of our community still have debris to remove. Please be patient as cleanup efforts are mainly concentrated on the areas hardest hit in other municipalities.

Please follow the County link below put in place for donations.

- The Donations Management program is now available with the State Volunteer Organizations Active in Disasters (NJVOAD). The public may now reach out for donating online at: <https://helpnjinow.communityos.org/donations>
- Gloucester County OEM Reception Center at the Mullica Hill Library will reopen Tuesday from 10:00 - 1800. Light refreshments, shelter information and charging stations will be available to assist those impacted by the tornado. FEMA is in the process of setting up a Disaster Recovery Center at the Mullica Hill Library. A Mobile command post was set up there today and will be back again tomorrow morning.
- A debris removal conference took place and a plan is under way on how all debris will be removed.
- PST's and EMS will continue to walk and conduct well-being checks with residents within the affected areas. Tomorrow Gloucester County OEM will have out flyers with pertinent to recovery efforts.
- Municipalities have been instructed to stop taking donations and advise individuals in their municipalities to stop collecting as well.
